Handled By Two People



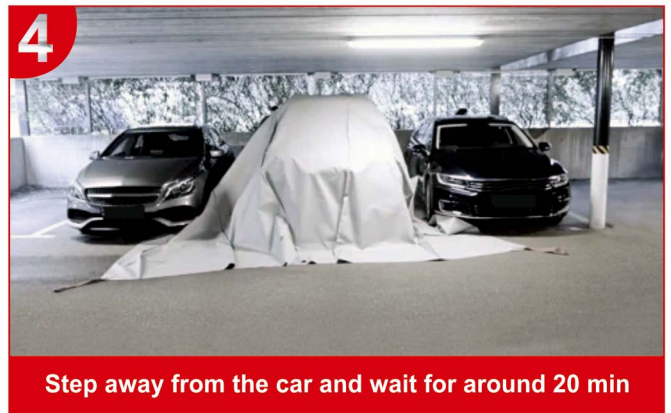
1 Place the fire blanket on the ground in front the car and rolled up into the centre from both sides
